Listen-Sort-Empower has now been endorsed by many departments within the VA as a model to engage staff to combat burnout, improve practice efficiency and professional fulfillment, while developing servant leadership behaviors. They presented their LSE journey at the Healthcare Burnout Symposium in February 2025.
